Lesson

1. Present PPT.

2. Once completed, divide students into small groups. Have groups brainstorm ways in which they can become healthier. Caution students that, to be successful, they should think of realistic goals.

3. Have each small group create a poster that shows their ideas as a way to teach others what they've learned.

4. Share posters with the whole-class
